Show the position of exterior and interior doors	
Have a male and female restroom	
Have a kitchen area	
Have a small office area for management	
Contain a colour-coded legend	
Use appropriate symbols for features (e.g., doors, windows, etc)	

You must use a scale and rule your measurements as precisely as possible.
